## GUARANTEE FUND INTEREST

This month we are giving you a taste of what to expect in December. No, it's not your BONUS just yet, but interest on your Guarantee Fund account. Study your September 2008 account statement carefully and you will see that we have given you interest. The interest rate varies between 3% and 6% depending on the balance of your Guarantee Fund account.

## THE PURCHASE MONTH

The Koopkrag purchase month opens on the 16<sup>th</sup> of a month and closes on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following month. To explain it we will use your October 2008 account as an example.

The October account opens on the 16<sup>th</sup> of September 2008. What exactly does 'open' mean? It means that your approved monthly purchase limit is once again available on the morning of the 16<sup>th</sup>. If you have a purchase limit of R5 000 for example, this will be the available amount. The purchase month usually opens on the 16<sup>th</sup> of each and every month, **irrespective of the day of the week**, unless we have notified you beforehand of any changes in this regard.

The October account closes on the 15<sup>th</sup> of October 2008. This is the last day of the month to utilise the remainder of that month's purchase limit. Any amount of the purchase limit remaining **will not be transferred to the following month**.

To provide our suppliers with ample opportunity to send us your transaction details we will most likely only finalise your account statements by the 20<sup>th</sup> of October. Only then will the statements be prepared and sent by post or e-mail. To qualify for a bonus on this month's purchases the account has to be settled in full by the 3<sup>rd</sup> of November 2008.

The purchase year for the calculation of your 2008 bonus opened on the 16<sup>th</sup> of August 2007 and has already ended on the 15<sup>th</sup> of August 2008. Your purchases for this 12 month period, excluding fuel, will be used to calculate your bonus.
