### YOUR GUIDE TO POLICY MANAGEMENT

Although **Santam** and **Koopkrag** update your policy regularly, it remains very important that you carefully review your insurance cover at least once a year. You can follow the following simple guidelines to ensure that your cover reflects the value of your possessions.
